For skin excisions and lacerations, you will usually need a long or prolonged visit, as per fees above. Your doctor will bulk bill any applicable additional fees to Medicare. Usual consultation fees apply to visits that involve dressings if the dressings are not part of routine aftercare relating to procedures done at Cammeray Medical Practice

Please note that the rebate is what the government insurer, Medicare, is willing to pay you for the item; it is set at a level much lower than it costs private practices to provide the service. Unfortunately this is why there are gap fees on most items.

Please note on rare occasions your doctor may choose to reduce your fee via a discount or bulk-billing; this is entirely at the doctor's discretion
